

Scale of Fees for Overseas Students (2026)

The Caulfield Grammar School Council has approved the following Scale of Fees for 2026.

Application for Enrolment Fee: a non-refundable and non-transferable fee of \$250, which is payable upon submission by a parent or legal guardian of an application to enroll their child at the School.

Confirmation of Enrolment Fee: a non-refundable and non-transferable fee payable in respect of each student, comprising the \$1,200 Enrolment Fee and a 50% prepayment of the Annual Total Fee and including Boarding Fees where applicable.

Caulfield Grammar School's Annual Total Fee for students from overseas includes the following:

- An Annual Tuition Fee;
- A State Payroll Tax Surcharge covering the cost of compulsory State Payroll Tax and Levies. This charge or portion of the charge is non-refundable or non-transferable and is subject to change for increases or decreases in State Payroll Tax and/or Levies;
- An Additional Fee covering: compulsory Government Medical Insurance Fee; and the Year Level Consolidated Charge which covers the cost of compulsory extras applicable to each Year level including class-set books and materials, films, Year Level camps, prescribed excursions and incursions, provision of certain technology resources (excluding iPads, laptops or equivalent devices in years 7-12), access to services and a special activities program fee.

The following additional charges may apply:

- Boarding Fees, if applicable; and
- At Year 9 an additional charge for the Year 9 Outdoor Education Experience.

Caulfield Grammar School fees exclude costs for:

- Uniforms;
- Books and stationery included in the year level booklists;
- Individually prescribed iPads, laptops or equivalent devices from years 7 – 12;
- Accommodation for day students;
- Transport to and from the School;
- Any courses or optional programs taken outside the School.

Please note the following:

- In accordance with the requirements of the Department of Education and Training other required information is to be provided when requested;
- The School's policy on refund of fees referred to in the Terms and Condition and this notice does not reserve the right of the student to take further action under Australia's Consumer Protection Laws; and
- The School's grievance resolution processes do not circumscribe the student's right to pursue other legal remedies.

Rendering of Accounts

For 2026, Tuition Fees, Boarding Fees, State Payroll Tax Surcharge and Additional Fees for Caulfield Grammar School (the School) will be rendered in two equal instalments in October 2025 and April 2026.

All fees, charges and surcharges incurred are payable within 14 days of an account being rendered. Parents may elect to pay fees, charges and surcharges as listed in the above Scale of Fees table under the monthly instalment payment option or a Lump Sum payment option detailed below. Payments will be applied to the oldest outstanding balance first. Accounts for additional fees, including but not limited to music charges, bus fees, optional programs, may be rendered from time to time during the year and are payable within 14 days of an account being rendered.

Payment can be made online at www.caulfieldgs.vic.edu.au by Visa, MasterCard and AMEX, by phone using Visa, MasterCard and AMEX, or by BPAY. Please note the School does not accept cash or cheque payments. Credit card transactions other than those made via BPAY may incur a credit card surcharge, which vary subject to changes in relevant laws or credit card provider fees and charges. Any debit card or credit card payment which is declined by the bank for any reason may incur an administration fee of \$50.

Monthly instalment payment option

For Parents with an Australian Bank Account the School offers the option to pay over 9 monthly instalments to be completed by 30 June each year. If this option is selected, the fees will require payment by nine monthly sequential instalments commencing October through to and including June. To take advantage of



these arrangements the monthly instalments must be made by direct debit. Any direct debit payment that is declined by the bank for any reason may incur an administration fee of \$50

GST

Currently school fees are GST free.

Building Fund

The School maintains an active building program at each campus, and to enable parents to contribute to this program there is an opportunity for a voluntary contribution to be made on each instalment's fee billing statement. Donations to the School's Building Fund are tax deductible and a receipt will be forwarded in July each year.

Optional programs and services

For an additional fee, optional programs and services which are not included in the curriculum may be taken, for example private music, instrument tuition, bus services, etc. The accounts for these optional programs and services are generally rendered at the end of each Term.
